

**BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

Brighton & Hove (Kingsway) (Prohibition of Left Turn) Order 202* (TRO-c-2026)

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 and 19 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) as amended and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall be cited as the “Brighton & Hove (Kingsway) (Prohibition of Left Turn) Order 202*”.
2. The provisions of this Order will come into operation on the ** day of ***** 202*.
3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expression has this meaning assigned to them: -

“**Emergency Services Vehicle**” means a vehicle operated by the police, fire & rescue service or ambulance service;

“**Vehicle**” means a mechanically propelled or pedal powered form of transportation intended or adapted for use on the road;

4. Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or a numbered Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order unless specified otherwise.
5. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or person authorised by the Council cause or permit any vehicle to make a left turn from A259 Kingsway onto Hove Street South Hove.
6. Article 5 shall not apply to an Emergency Service Vehicle being used by the emergency services in response to an incident or in the course of official emergency duties.
7. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act, and existing when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on movement by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
