

# **Brighton & Hove Public Health Framework for Assessing Alcohol Licensing**

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## Notes on the data

### Crime and disorder data

All crime and disorder data is for the 2017-18 period.

Data used in this report is downloaded from the live system at Sussex Police each month. This data has not been audited or verified by statisticians at Police HQ, therefore it represents a reflection of crime and disorder in the area, rather than the authorised and fully verified 'performance data'.

Only those crimes and incidents where there was sufficient location information to map to ward level have been included.

**It is important to note that the Police crime statistics used in this report are proxy indicators for alcohol related crime and will not all be alcohol related. These crime types have been chosen as they are most likely to be associated with alcohol.**

*Injury Violence* includes all assault with injury offences, as well as violence against the person offences of greater severity such as murder, attempted murder and manslaughter.

*Non-injury assaults* include common assault and battery offences, racially or religiously motivated common assault or beating offences, and assaults on a constable.

All *Violence Against the Person* offences include injury violence, non-injury assaults, as well as a range of harassment and other offences.

*Criminal damage* offences can include damage to dwellings, vehicles or buildings 'other than a dwelling'.

*Sexual offences* include rape and other sexual offences, such as sexual assault and sexual activity involving children.

Data has been extracted using 'CADDIE' categories and police input date, and includes historical offences.

**There have been ongoing and significant changes to the recording of violent crime since this report was first published, and therefore crime figures are not comparable to previous editions.**

*Police recorded alcohol related incidents* are extracted from the police incident database using a search on the free text field (filled out as the call comes in) on the words alcohol, drink and drunk.

A police recorded incident is defined as 'a single distinct event or occurrence which disturbs an individual's, group's or community's quality of life or causes them concern'. **Due to recent changes to the way this data is cleaned and extracted from the police incident database please note that alcohol related incident data is not comparable with previous editions of this report.**

It is not considered appropriate to produce a rate per ward, as with health data, as comparison between an incident (which is likely to occur away from an individual's place of residence) and a resident population would not be correct.

## Health data

*Rates per 100,000* are for adults aged 15-59 years unless otherwise stated.

*Increasing risk or higher risk drinking* data is derived from the Health Counts Survey 2012. The data presented here is unchanged from that reported originally in September 2014 and is based on guidance that pre-dates that of the Chief Medical Officer of January 2016<sup>1</sup>. Increasing risk is defined as usual consumption of between 22 and 50 units of alcohol per week for men and between 15 and 35 units of alcohol per week for women. Higher risk drinking is defined as usual consumption of over 50 units of alcohol per week for men, and over 35 units of alcohol per week for women. Based upon place of residence.

*Alcohol suspected ambulance call outs* data is for financial year 2017/18 by ward (based on the 'Response Area'), and comes from South East Coast Ambulance Service. Ambulance patient clinical records (PCR) now contain an indicator for whether the crew on the scene suspect that alcohol has been involved with the incident. This has been collected since calendar year 2011. The guidance for collecting this data asks that a 'x' is placed in a designated box if alcohol is suspected. It is very much a judgment call of the crew on the scene, which will differ between individuals. Due to scanning and data validation, PCR data is 80-90% accurate. Additionally, diagnoses related to alcohol are also included, in addition to or as well as the 'suspected' field having been ticked. Given these caveats, it will not be a complete picture of the burden that alcohol places on ambulance services. However, it provides some quantification of alcohol related ambulance call outs, demographics of patients involved in such incidents, geographical areas where the totals are higher and the health implications (whether resulting in falls, overdose/poisoning etc). Based upon location of the call out.

*A&E attendances with a record of alcohol* is for 2017/18 and based on a key word search for terms related to alcohol applied to an extract from the main A&E system by Brighton & Sussex University Hospital Trust. These figures are collated from key word searches on the electronic A&E record and so could well underestimate the total attendances attributable to alcohol where the diagnosis has not referenced this causal factor. Data is for Brighton and Hove residents, aged 18 years or over. Based on place of residence.

*Clients in Alcohol Treatment* adults aged 18 years or over in Tier 3 (structured treatment) during 2017/18 financial year as a rate per 100,000 aged 18 years and over. Based on place of residence.

*Hospital admissions: wholly attributable (specific) alcohol conditions* 2017/18 comes from Health Episode Statistics (HES). This data is for alcohol specific person based admissions that are wholly attributable to alcohol, for example, alcohol-induced behavioural disorders and alcohol-related liver cirrhosis. The alcohol-attributable fraction is 1.0 because all cases (100%) are caused by alcohol.

*Alcohol Related Mortality 2015-2017* this data is extracted from the NHS Mortality File, using the updated alcohol-attributable fractions to calculate alcohol-specific mortality.

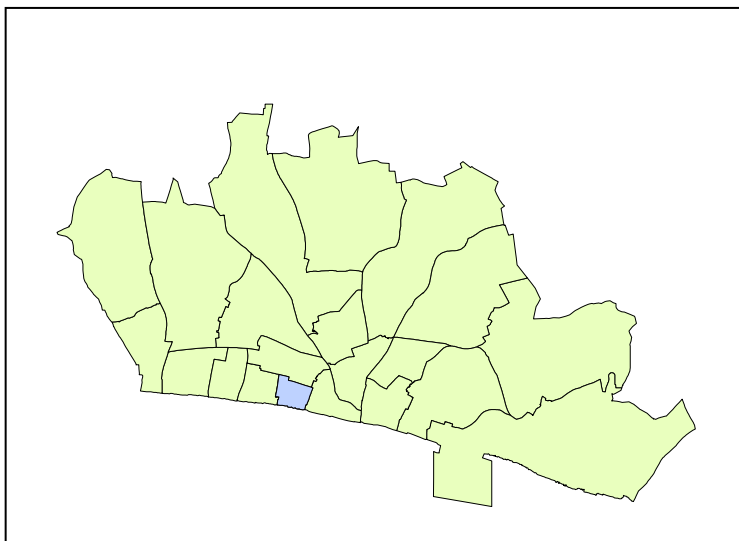

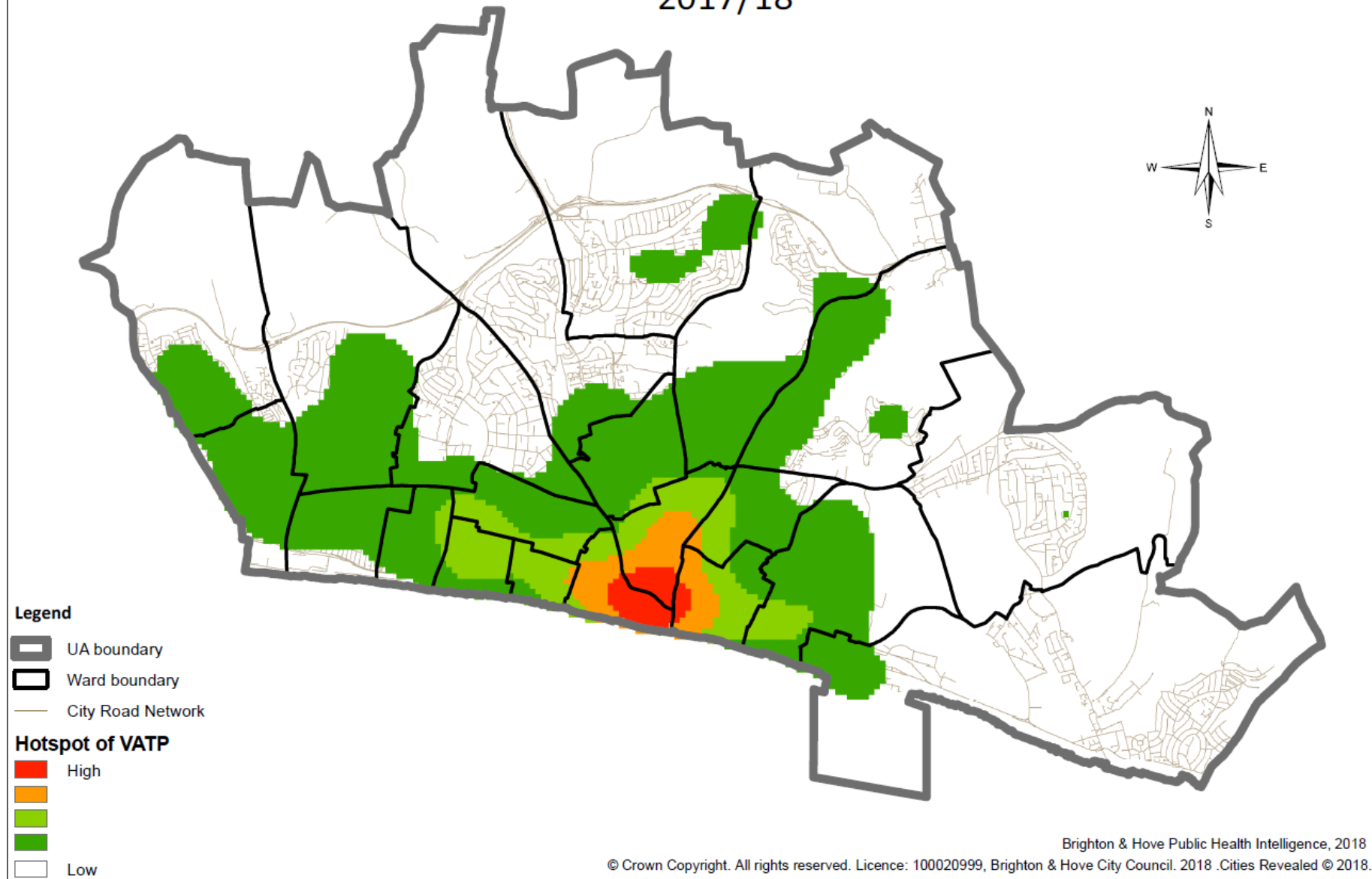

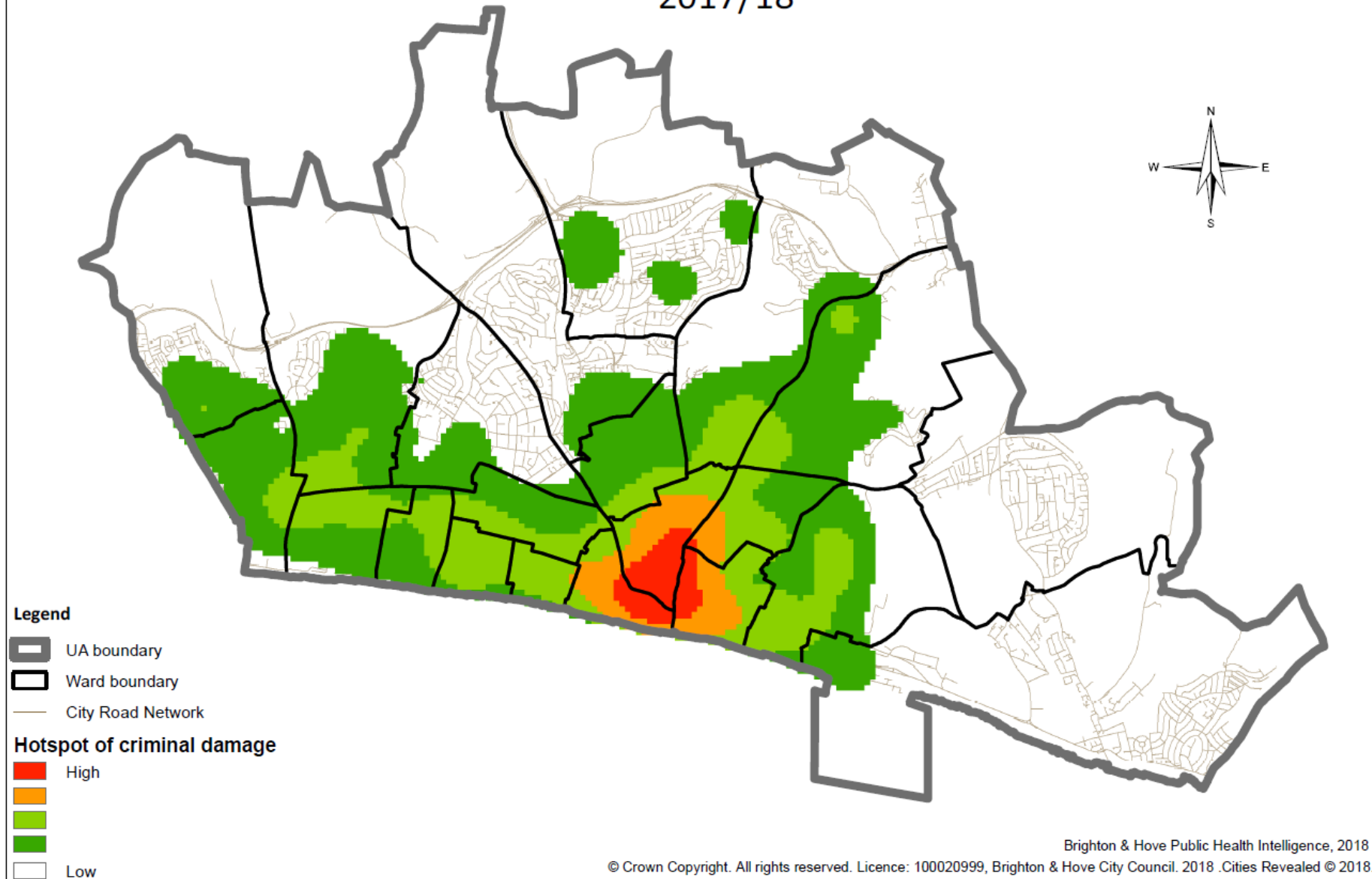
# Hotspot of police recorded alcohol related incidents (n=3,680) 2017/18



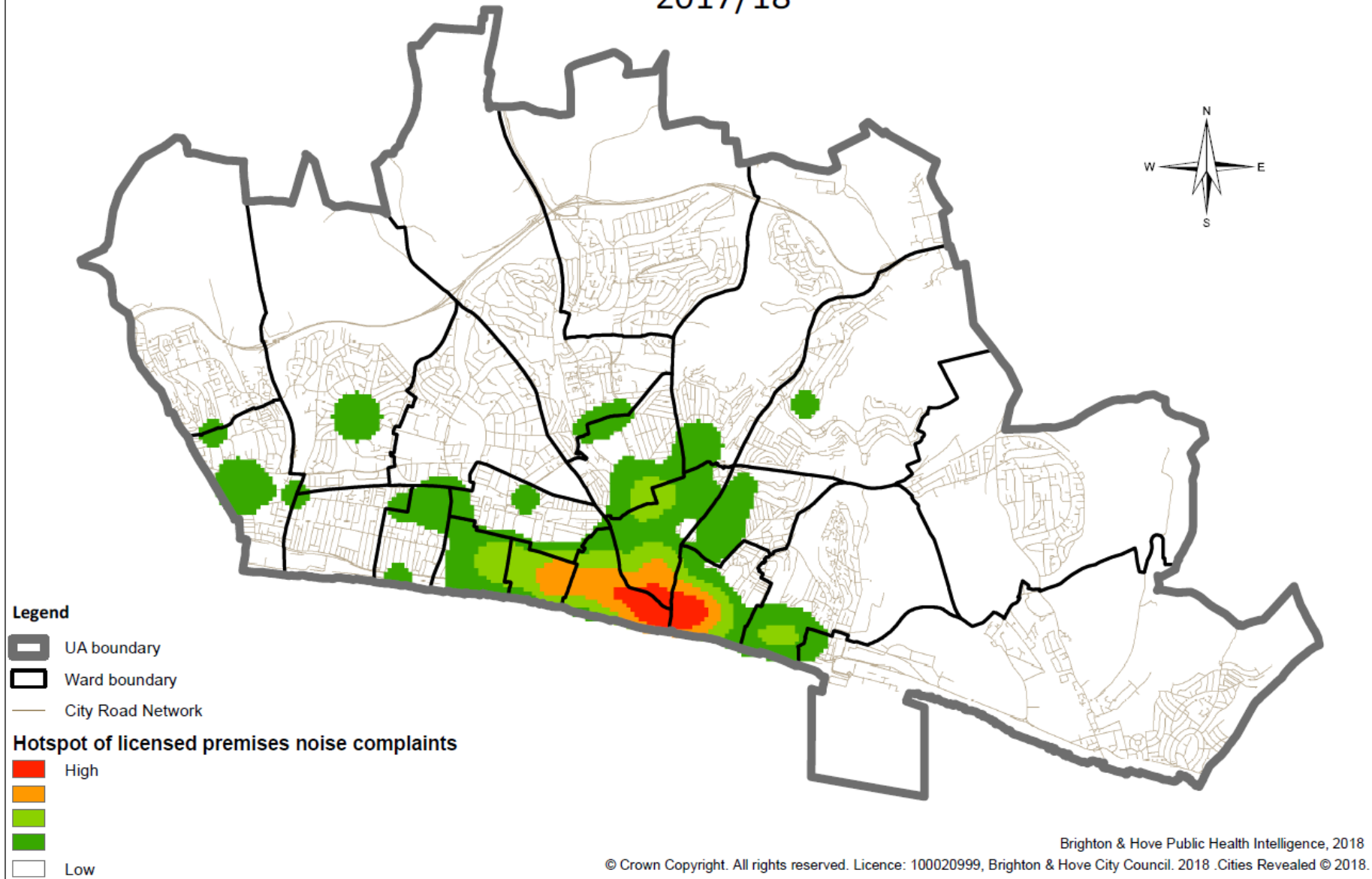
# Hotspot of police recorded violence against the person offences (n=10,711) 2017/18

# Hotspot of noise complaints regarding licensed premises (n=122) 2017/18

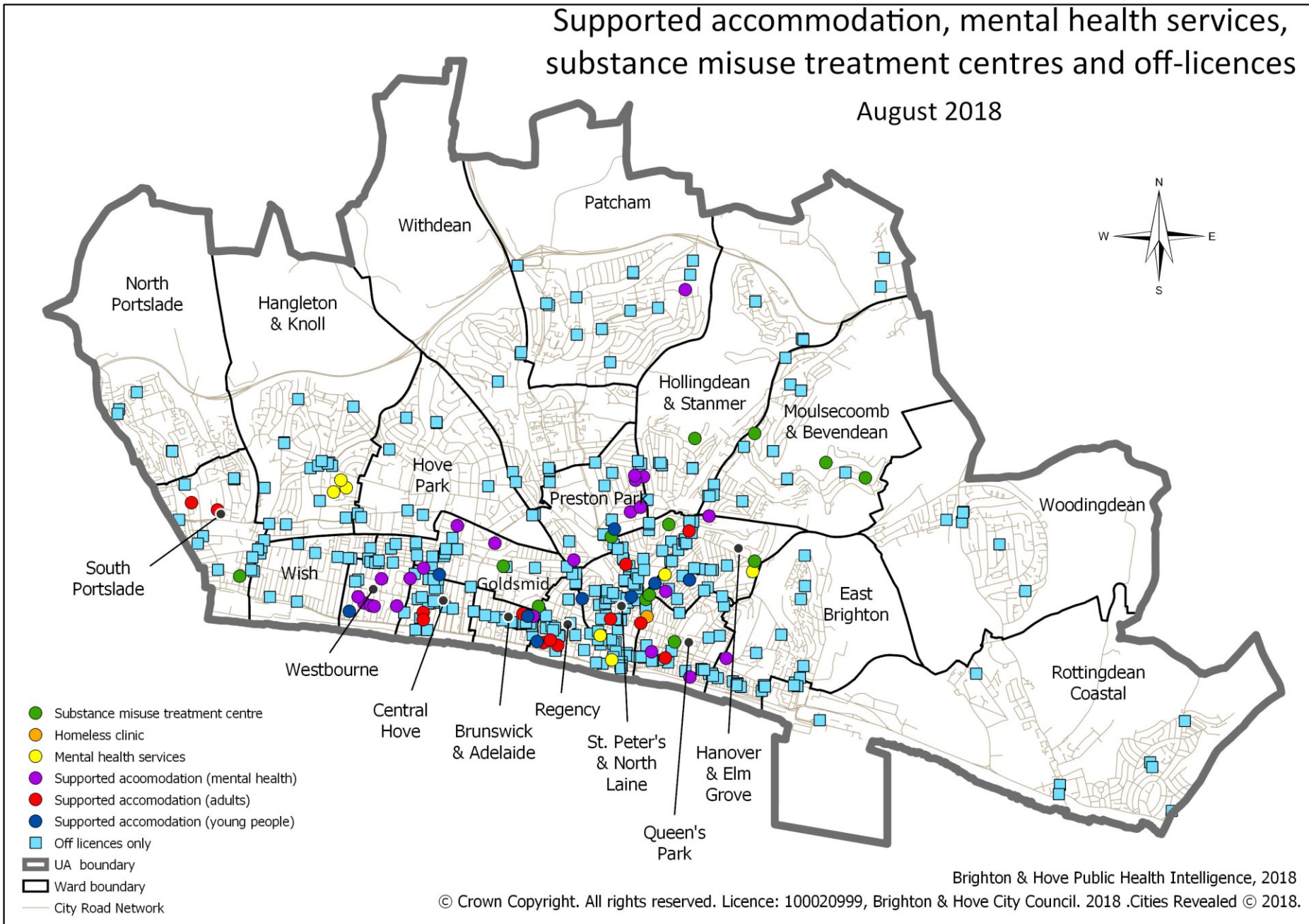
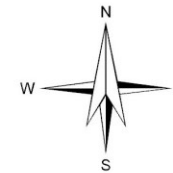

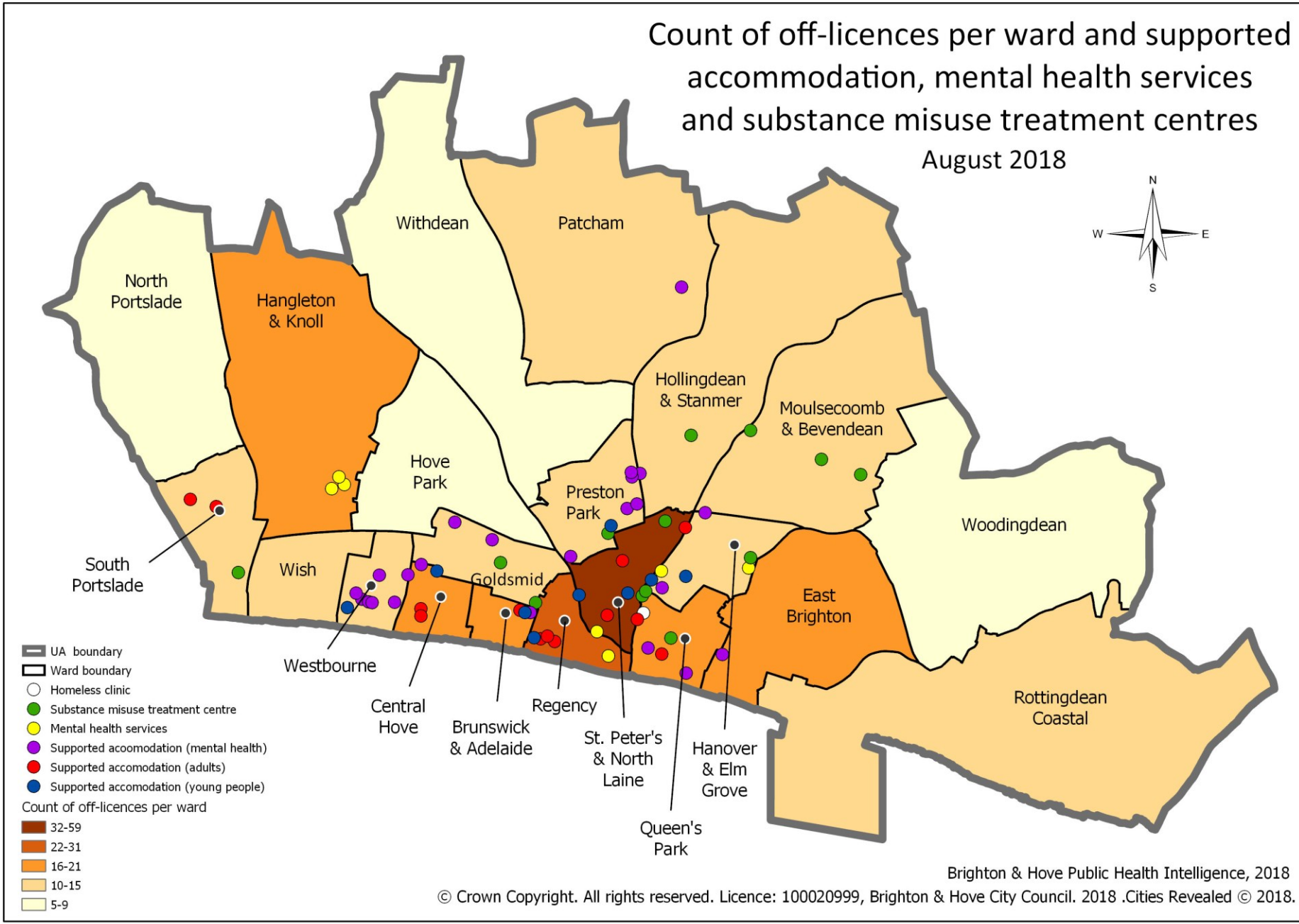
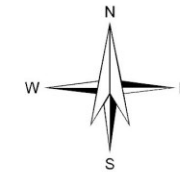


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# Count of off-licences per ward and supported accommodation, mental health services and substance misuse treatment centres August 2018

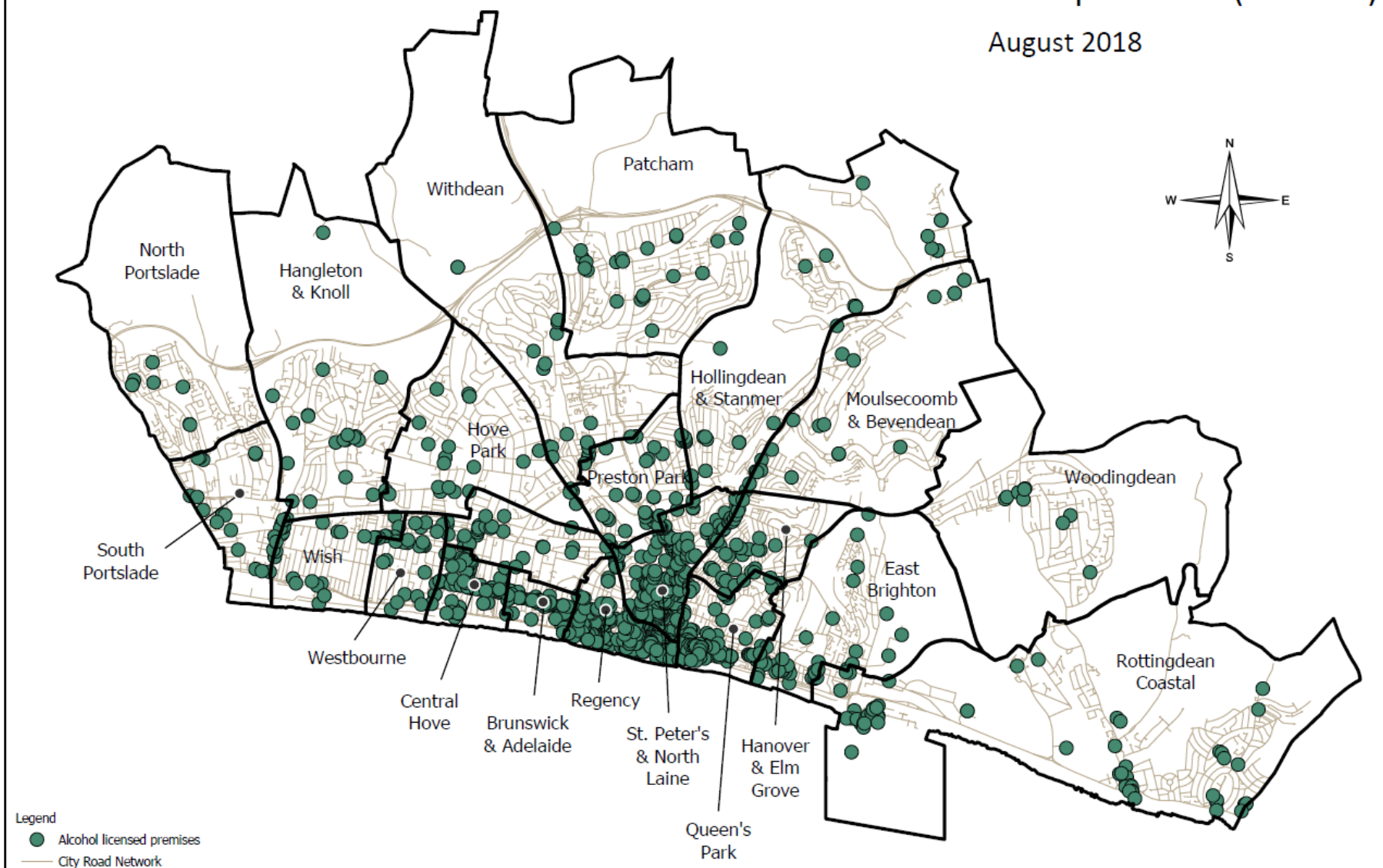

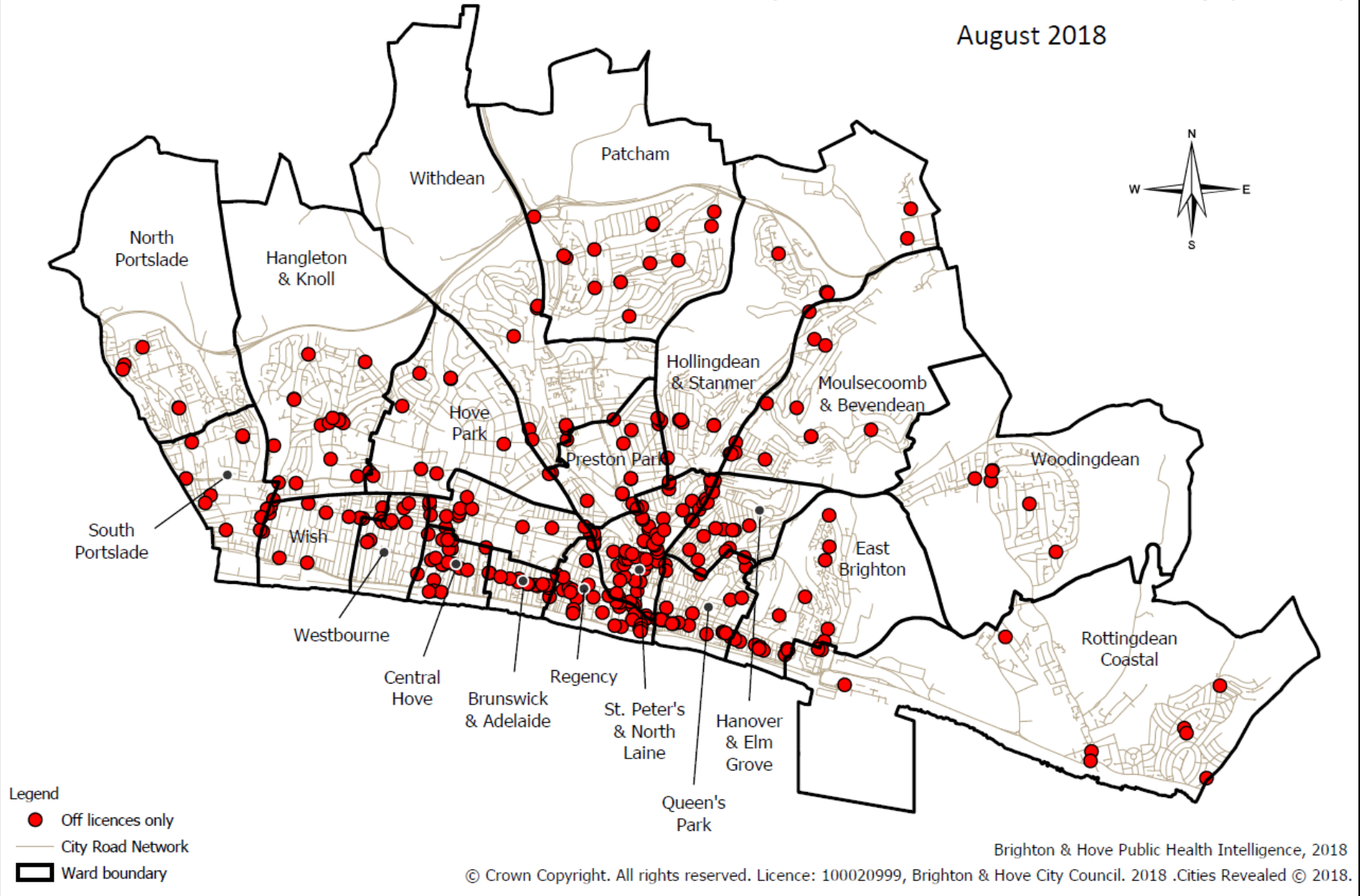

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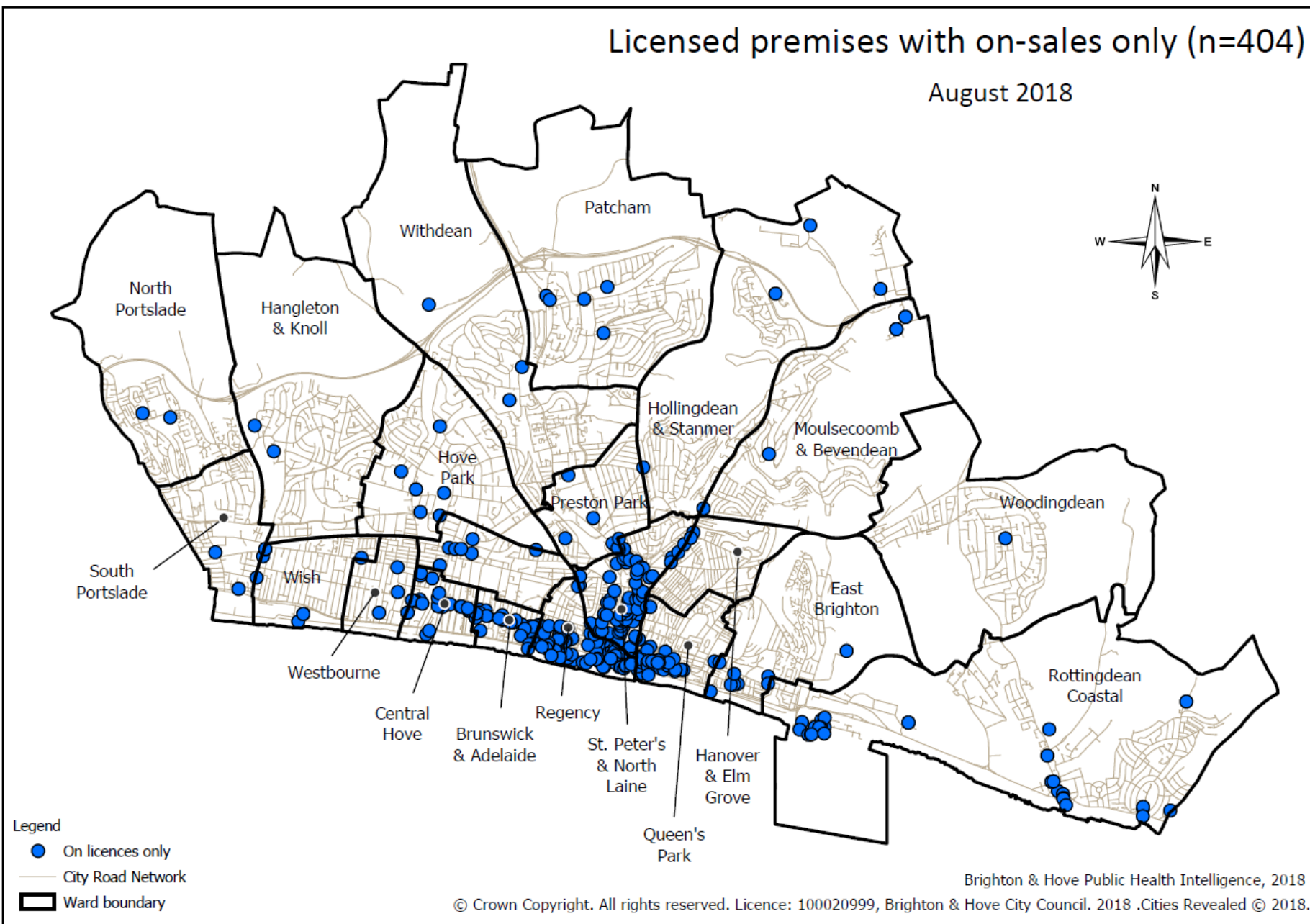

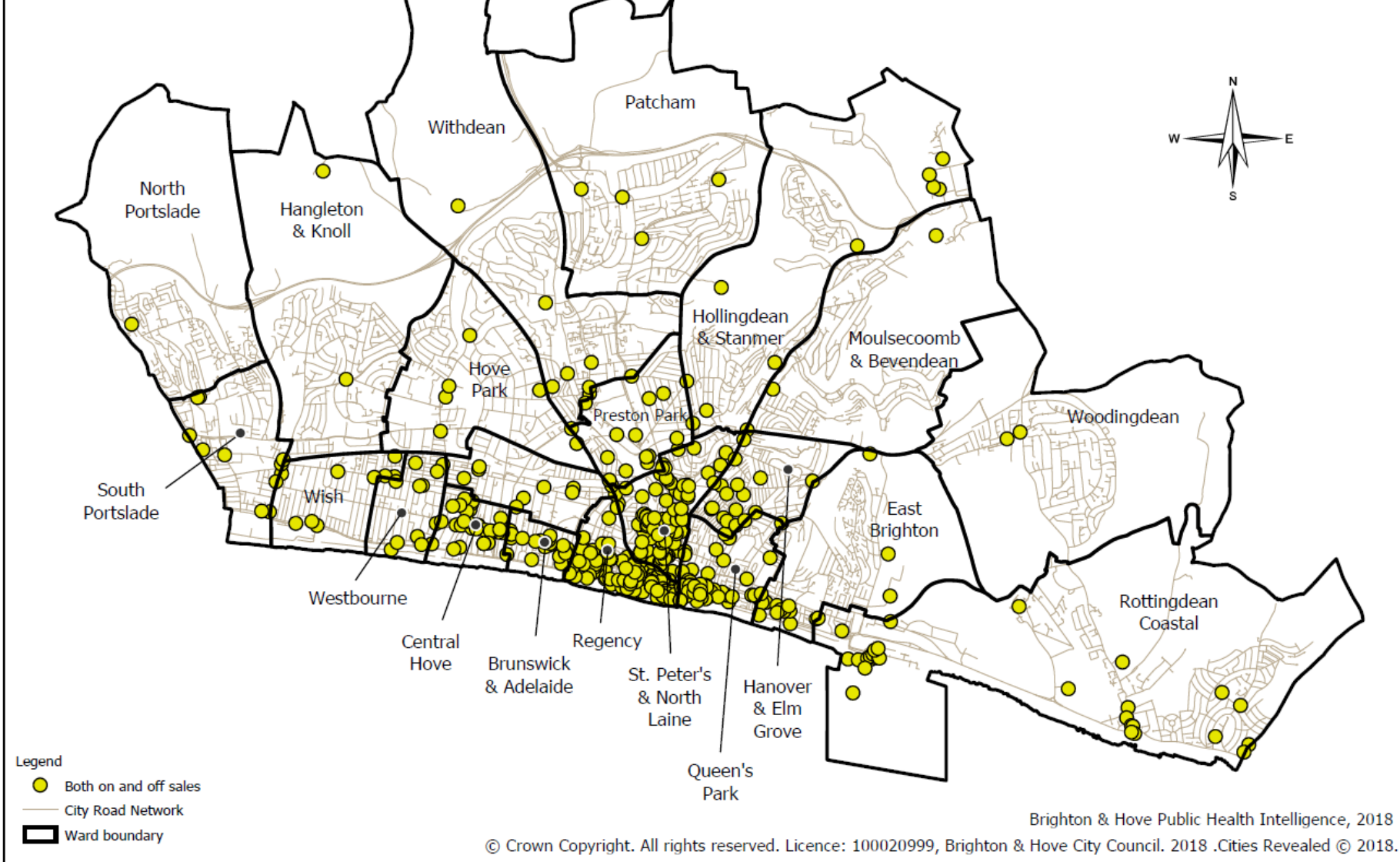
# Licensed premises with on-sales only (n=404)

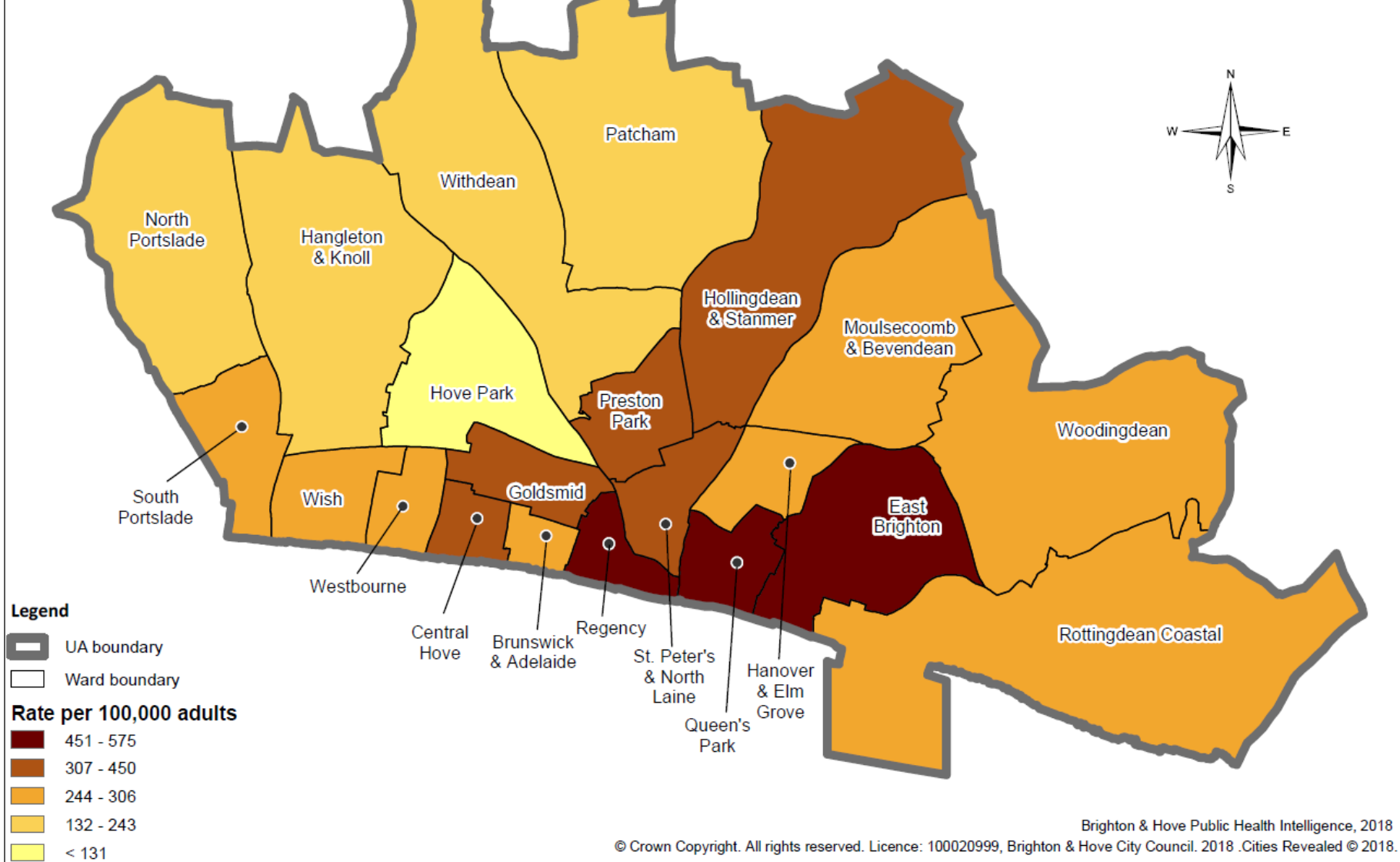


# Licensed premises with both on and off sales (n=484)

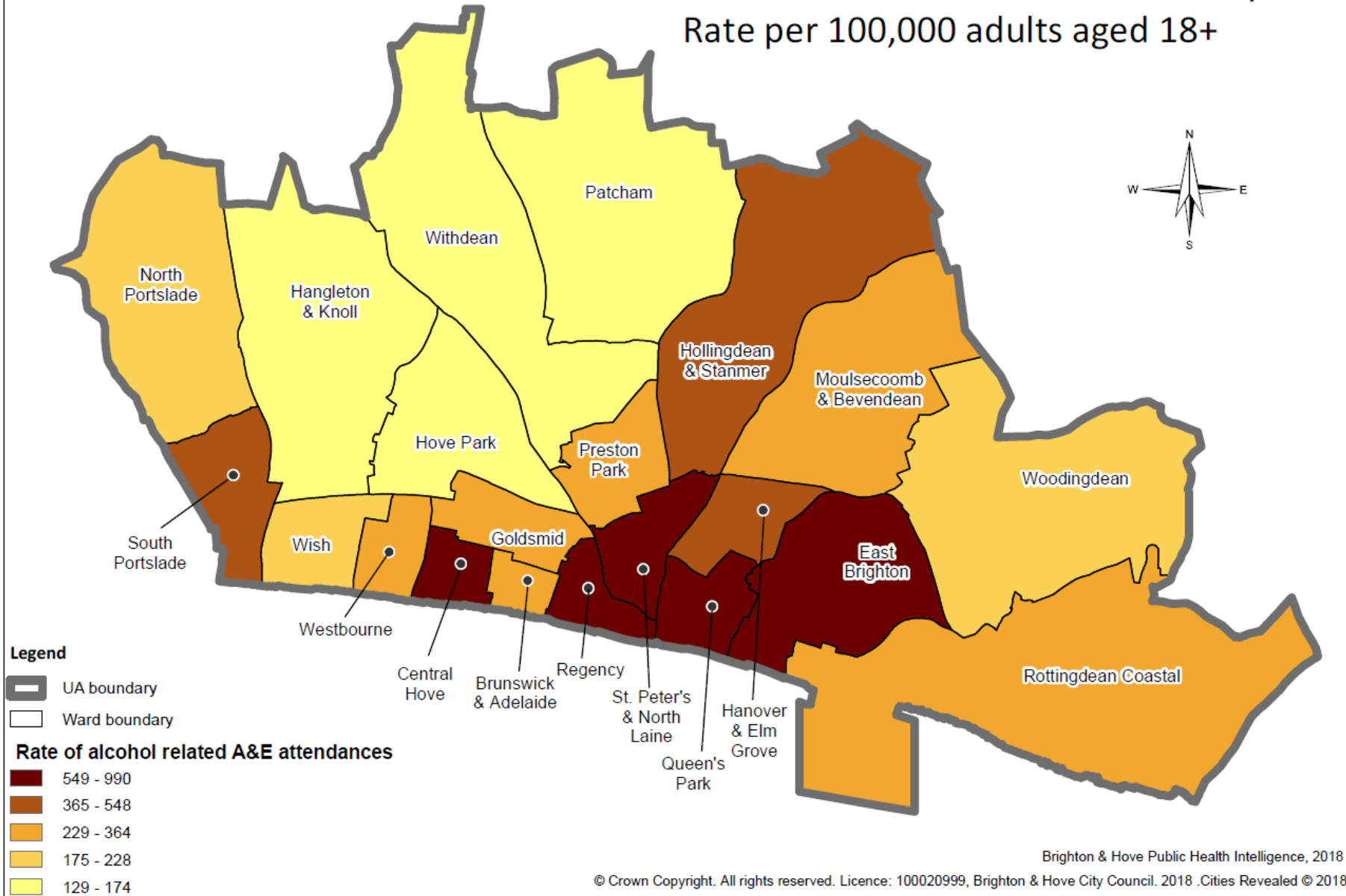


## Clients in alcohol treatment in 2017-18 by ward Rate per 100,000 adults aged 18+
