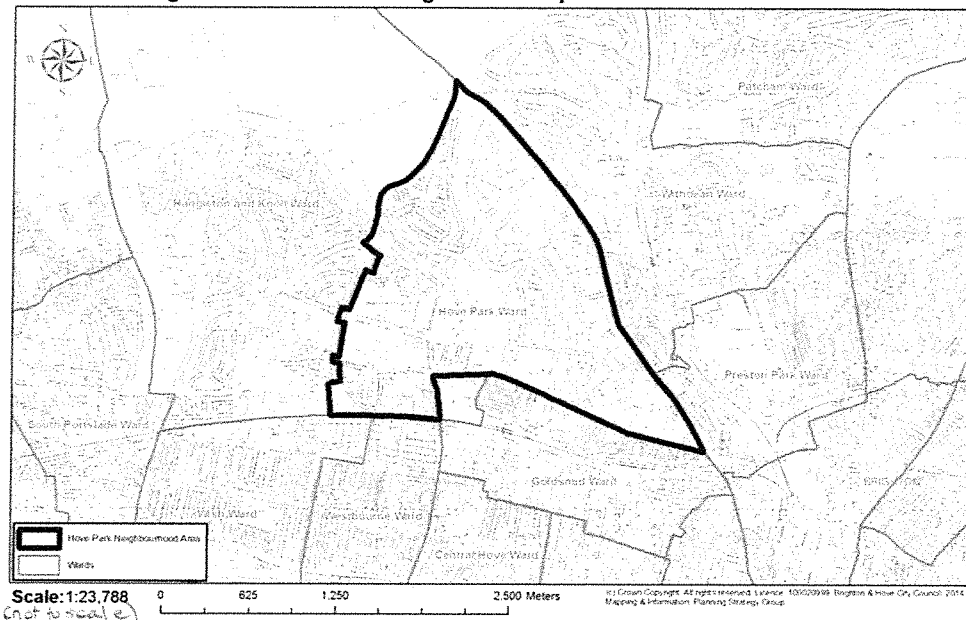


The Hove Park Neighbourhood Forum submits the following statement explaining how the forum meets the conditions contained in section 61F(5), Schedule 9 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. This reflects the neighbourhood area that got designated and replaces the statement originally detailed in section 6 of the application form:

Statement Explaining How the Hove Park Neighbourhood Forum Meets the Conditions in 61F(5) of the 1990 Act.

The Hove Park Neighbourhood Forum is established for the express purpose of promoting or improving the social, economic and environmental well-being of the Hove Park Neighbourhood Area.

The constitution of the Hove Park Neighbourhood Forum including a map showing the extent of the neighbourhood area is attached. The constitution was agreed by the forum at a meeting held on 29th June 2015.

The main reason for developing a neighbourhood plan is that it is considered the most effective way in which local residents and businesses can influence the implementation of the Brighton and Hove City Council's City Plan.

Membership of the Hove Park Neighbourhood Forum is open to all who live in and/or work in the neighbourhood area and/or are elected members of Brighton & Hove City Council.

Volunteers knocked on doors throughout Hove Park Ward, as well as emailing/telephoning residents who contacted us expressing their desire for a Forum to be established for Hove Park.

All residents will be leafleted to ask for their views and to invite residents to attend two information sessions, at different venues in the Hove Park Ward area.

The number of Hove Park Neighbourhood Forum members is significantly greater than the 21 required by legislation and comprises of individuals who comply with the membership criteria and includes at least one of the three categories (resident, worker, elected member). 
The Constitution of the Hove Park Neighbourhood Forum is attached. The constitution was agreed by the Forum at a meeting held on 29th June 2015. It reflects with the Hove Park Neighbourhood Area designated on the 18 September 2014 and replaces the constitution dated Tuesday, 18th February 2014.


All the residents groups are supporting the Forum for Hove Park. They are Goldstone Valley Residents Association, Woodland Drive Action Committee, Hove Park Residents Association and Barrowfield Residents Association. We also have members who belong to the "Friends of the Copse" and newly formed "Friends of Hove Park".


The main purpose of the forum is to develop a neighbourhood plan, which is considered the most effective way in which local residents and businesses can influence the implementation of the Brighton & Hove City Council's city plan.

The Hove Park Neighbourhood Area includes a range of sites where change may happen such as smaller industrial/commercial areas and the environs of the Engineerium. It also includes major facilities used by residents such as schools, Hove Park, Hove Recreation Playing Fields, Nevill Playing Fields, The Greyhound Stadium, the allotments and the Copse.
