



Patching Lodge, Eastern Road (on the corner of Freshfield Road)

The ornamental gates and railings that form the entrance to the Patching Lodge housing development were designed and made by artist Chris Campbell and installed in 2009. The gates decorative design consists of a central circular eye, with a concentrated swirl formation that lessens in detail and becomes freer towards the outer railings. Chris Campbell is sole artist at Campbell Designs which is based in the north Nottinghamshire village of Mattersey and is dedicated to the design and construction of bespoke items and environments. The sculptural gates and railings act as a feature entrance at Patching Lodge and are an example of their holistic approach to environmental streetscape design.
