





Population count of households affected by the Under 35 housing benefit changes (change from the one bedroom property rate to the shared room rate)







Population count of customers or partners working while in receipt of Housing & Council tax benefit







Count 77 Housing Benefit claims affected Tenancies between Oct 1996 – Feb 2004


