### The project

The scheme is located in Central Brighton. The footprint of the Valley Gardens Phase 1 and 2 project stretches from North of St Peters Place junction to just South of Church Street and includes both Highway and Green Space.

Valley Gardens is focused on two strategic routes and offers significant improvements to the gardens within the project boundary. The key principles of the Valley Gardens proposals are to simplify the existing highway network making the journey through Valley Gardens less complicated and more legible for all users, improving cycle and pedestrian networks and improving safety.

### Provisional Scheme Programme

- Contract commencement: 3 September 2018
- Planned completion: September 2020
- Duration: 24 months

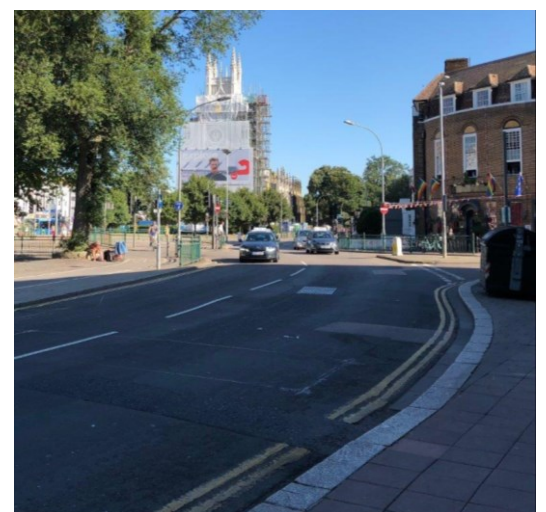
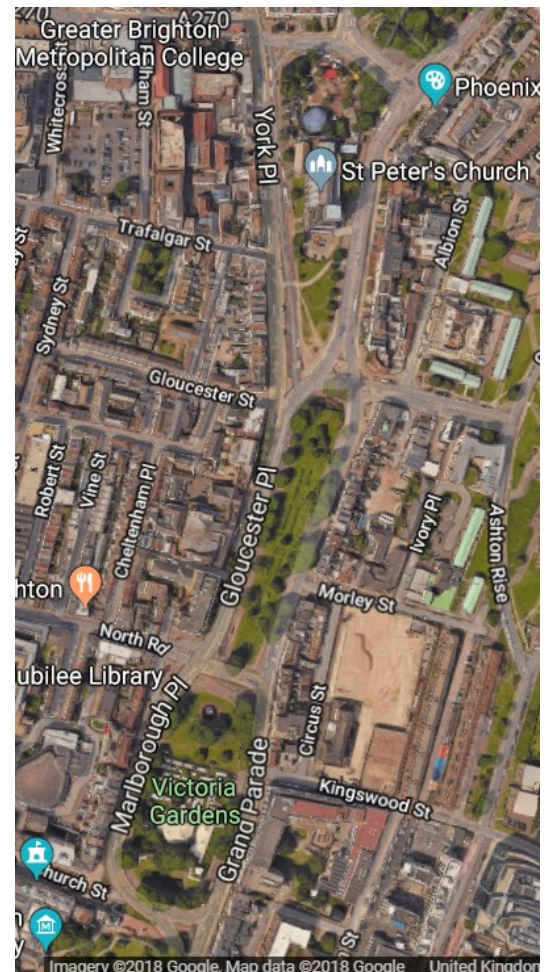
### Phase 1

Phase 1 works will commence on the eastern side of Valley Gardens encompassing the footway and near side carriageway of Richmond Place and Grand Parade. Richmond Parade junction with Grand Parade works will also be undertaken within phase 1.

- **Phase 5:** 13<sup>th</sup> May 2019 to 9<sup>th</sup> September 2019
- **Phase 6:** 11<sup>th</sup> September 2019 to 24<sup>th</sup> October 2019
- **Phase 7:** 25<sup>th</sup> October 2019 to 14<sup>th</sup> November 2019
- **Phase 8:** 25<sup>th</sup> October 2019 to 6<sup>th</sup> December 2019
- **Phase 9:** 25<sup>th</sup> October 2019 to 4<sup>th</sup> November 2019
