Progress since last month

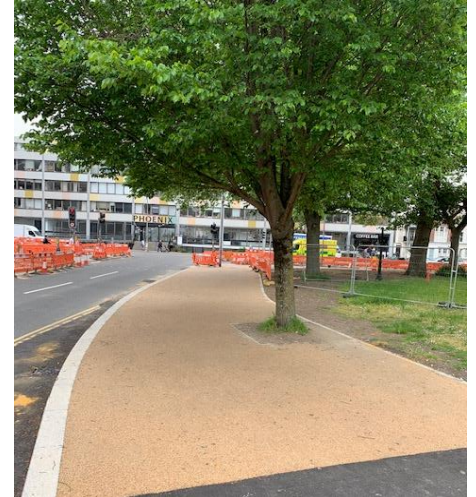
This month has been an exciting one with the first section of resin bound gravel being laid on the Valley Gardens Improvement scheme. This innovative and hard wearing surface will form the base of many of the new shared footways across the green spaces of Valley Gardens. It is designed with a permeable surface to allow water to reach tree roots. This will reduce the 'lifting' affect the roots have on the existing surface.

We are now starting to see the layout of the new cycle lanes on the western side of Richmond Place. These new cycle routes will provide a direct link through the Valley Gardens area, making it easier for cyclists to make a continuous journey through the city centre.

Where the cycle routes and pedestrian areas meet, we have installed areas of specialised tactile paving designed to warn cyclists that they are entering an area frequented by pedestrians. This will ensure all footway users can share the new areas with equal priority.

Works at St Peter's Place continue towards completion with a new segregated island being constructed in the centre of St Peter's Place to delineate between the westbound general traffic lane and the dedicated eastbound bus and taxi lane.

Dyer & Butler are proud to announce that we have received an acknowledgement of all our efforts on the Valley Gardens Improvement Scheme by being awarded a 'very good' following the Considerate Constructors Scheme site inspection report undertaken in May this year.



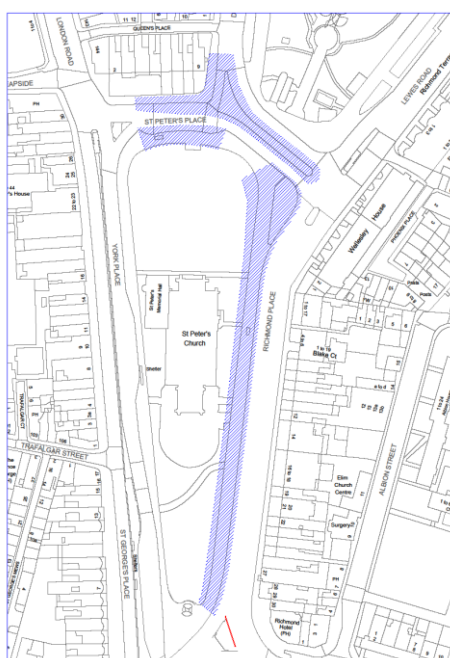
Planned works for this month

Works this month will continue at St Peter's Place, including moving the Taxi Rank to a temporary pick up and drop off position on the north side of St Peter's Place.

Once the current phase of St Peter's Place work is completed, the focus of our efforts will move to the east side of Valley Gardens where works will commence to make shared spaces available to all traffic.
